Ballet Cymru is an international touring ballet company for Wales, committed to inclusion and innovation in dance and classical ballet, and to the highest standard of collaboration. Its extensive access and outreach programme is committed to breaking down barriers to accessing the arts.

Ballet Cymru is based in Rogerstone, Newport, and has been hosting dance intensive courses in Wales for over twenty years.

Course information

Our Wales Summer Dance course (WSD) takes place at **Ballet Cymru Studios** this year, with the final day to be held at The Riverfront Theatre and Arts Centre. Join us on this weeklong intensive with classes taught by the professional dancers of the company.

The course includes ballet technique class, company ballet repertoire and new creative choreography. Pointe work experience is not necessary for this course.

There will be a performance of work created throughout the week on the final day of the course. This performance will be on the main stage at The Riverfront and will be free for friends and family to attend.

Ballet Cymru strives to be an inclusive company and welcomes applications from disabled dancers or those from protected characteristics.

Participants must apply for a place on the course and there are limited spaces available. We encourage early application for a better chance of being selected onto the course.

This course is for dancers with previous ballet experience. Applicants are expected to be age 10+. All applicants must complete an online application form. Applicants will be accepted onto the course on a first come first serve basis, only if they meet the criteria expected for the course. Applications must be submitted before **Friday 27th June 2025** and may not be considered if received after this date.
